## Admission Procedure

Students who have passed the SEE or equivalent exams (ICSE, CBSE, O Level) are eligible to apply for admission at UA. All students need to pass the Entrance Test on the following subjects:

### For Science Faculty:

- Compulsory English, Optional Mathematics, Compulsory Mathematics, and Science

### For Management, Humanities and Law Faculties:

- Compulsory English, Compulsory Nepali, and Compulsory Mathematics

Group	Minimum Requirement
Science	Minimum GPA: 3.0 with Optional Mathematics. Minimum Grade point: C+ in all subjects.
Management, Humanities & Law	Minimum GPA: 2.0 Minimum Grade point: C in all subjects.

\* Admission will be granted based on the merit list of the Entrance Test. The UA administration has the right to reject application forms with incomplete information and papers. It also has the absolute right to decide the final admission only after an oral interview with subject experts.



# Academic Evaluation

UA values a hands-on approach to education, which is why we regularly evaluate our students. We conduct Unit Tests, Class Tests, Terminal Examinations, Mock Examinations, and Send-up Examinations throughout the year. For students who may need additional support, we offer re-examination opportunities and practical revision classes.

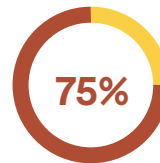
Science students can revise Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Computer Science, and Biology for preparing their NEB Final Exam. Management students can focus on Computer Science, Marketing, and Hotel Management, while Humanities students can focus on Sociology, Mass Communication, and Population Studies. - **Project Works writing and presentations for all streams.**

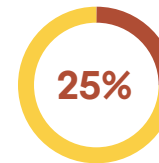
At our school, we believe in providing a comprehensive evaluation system that measures students' performance both inside and outside the classroom. Our evaluation

system is designed to be fair and transparent, based on a combination of internal and external assessments. Here's what you need to know about our evaluation process:

- 25% of the internal evaluation of the students is based on their performance from their internal work, such as homework, classroom behavior, disciplinary activities, and attendance.
- 75% of the evaluation of the student is based on their performance on terminal examinations, such as board exams, internal exams like unit tests, and boards.

The academy also provides students with **Chapter-wise as well as Model questions** to familiarize them with the Board exam patterns and possible question formats. Regular revision/discussion classes are held after send-up exams to ensure students are well-prepared for the Board exams. The academy aims to provide students with a comprehensive learning experience that sets them up for academic success.

### ASSIGNMENTS

We believe that regular revision is the key to retaining knowledge and building long-term understanding. That's why students are assigned ample homeworks every week, across all subjects. The homework is checked and returned promptly, helping students stay on top of their studies and track their progress.

### PROJECT WORKS

At UA, students are allowed to put their knowledge into practice and develop important research skills. They are required to complete and submit projects based on classwork and data collected from field visits to commercial, industrial, media, sociocultural, and scientific organizations. Under the guidance of subject teachers, students receive evaluation marks for their projects, which are eventually added to their final send-up results. Students are required to give PowerPoint presentations of their project work.

### STUDENT AS A TUTOR PROGRAM

Students tend to forget most of the lessons taught in classrooms. So, UA has adopted an approach to make them remember what they have learned. After the second term examination, students are made to deliver a lecture on whatever they have been taught from the beginning of the session. This is an essential part of the academic exercise.

### INTERACTION WITH PARENTS AND GUARDIANS

We have a tradition of regular interaction with parents and guardians. After each terminal examination, the Principal, Academic Head, Coordinators, Assistant Coordinators, Counselors, and the concerned faculty subject teachers discuss the academic performance of each student with his/her parent or guardian. Interaction with parents and guardians is also undertaken when students have serious issues with their studies, discipline, and class regularity.

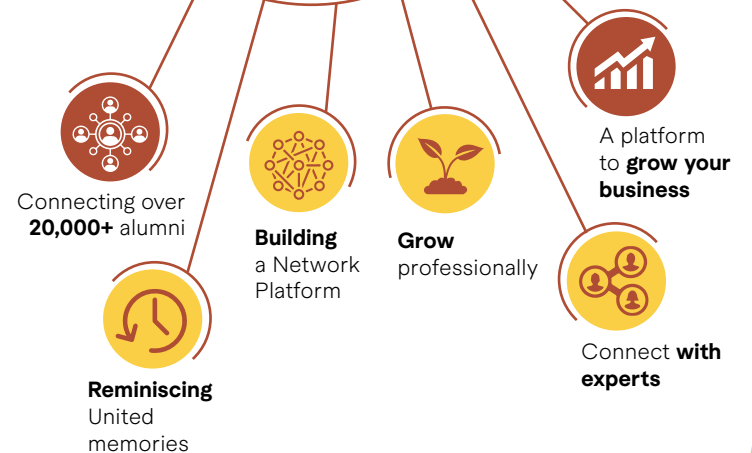


# United Alumni Association

# Code of Conduct


UA sincerely believes that quality education comes with discipline. UA does not compromise on the violation of the Academy's codes of conduct by any student. All students must abide by the following codes of the Academy.

- Attendance of students in all classes will be recorded daily at the first hour.
- Only students with proper uniforms and neat haircuts are allowed to enter the Academy's premises.

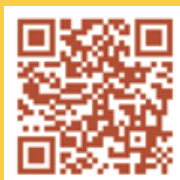
